A bespoke solar shading system, constructed using Accoya wood cladding on Scottish Widows' building at Exchange Place, Edinburgh has been revisited two years on to measure its performance. Not surprisingly, all 1,060 of the Accoya wood fins look as good as the day they were installed.

With Accoya's lasting performance, solar shading solutions specialist, Levolut, was able to offer a 10 year warranty for the finish and a life expectancy of 60 years.

Chosen for its structural stability, durability and because it is sustainably sourced, Accoya showed:

Accoya comes out on top in TRADA test

An independent report commissioned by world leaders in wood technology, Accsys Technologies, has shown Accoya outperforms all competing cladding boards.

Over the course of 32 months outdoors in an exposure trial by TRADA (the Timber Research and Development Association), the excellent coating performance of Accoya showed no signs of rot, decay or other surface coating issues.

When compared with other wood substrates such as pine and Siberian larch, for their comparative resistance to natural weathering and splitting, Accoya was outstanding. It showed virtually no shelling, cracking, checking or fissuring and boasted a clean, sound surface with excellent stability.
